These include (but are not limited to) toiletries, adult colouring books, and bonding hearts for parent/guardian and child for if they are ever apart from each other. 'The Pick Me Up Packages' would be given to the parent/guardian of a sick child who experiences an unexpected overnight stay in the hospital. These will be ongoing, and we will eventually be supplying the same to the Special Care Baby Unit in the Borders General Hospital too. In addition to the 'Pick Me Up Packages' we also provided tea, coffee and biscuits to parents at the Children's Ward at the Borders General Hospital. The 'Pick Me Up Packages' continue to be our focus until we have raised enough funds to expand our charitable activities.

Financial review

Brief statement of the charity's policy on reserves

The charity aims to maintain a minimum reserve of £5,000 in the bank annually, which has been comfortably achieved with a year-end account balance of £34,813.

While the fundraising target for the year was set at £5,000, the charity achieved a surplus of £4,950, narrowly below its target. Despite this small shortfall, the charity's overall financial position remains strong, supported by its healthy level of reserves.

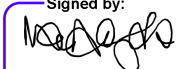

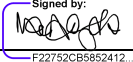

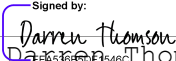
