Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

AGM November 2025 The Chairman's Report to the Trustees

As a National Christian Charity comprised of other local Christian Charities, the Church of God Scotland has many opportunities to be involved with improving the health and wellbeing of the people who live in the communities we serve. Our main purpose or goal as a Christian Charity is to introduce people to the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Our strategy to accomplish this goal is to love as Jesus loved and to serve as Jesus served. We held our National AGM in Perth on 31st October and 1st November 2025 at the request of our American based Overseer.

Dr Greg Sloop has informed me that because he does not live in Scotland, he has met up with most of our ministers during the winter months on Zoom to do some training with them. In the springtime he visited Scotland to do a three-day training session held in Glasgow in March. He also organized building teams from the USA to do some renovation work on the Dens Road building in Dundee during March and April. He held a National Convention meeting in Glasgow on 15th-17th May with a team of seven couple that came from the USA to train 140 delegates including children, ladies, and men. Dr Sloop also organized a team of builders from the USA to do some renovation work at the LEAD church in Glasgow.

During the summer months a National Youth Camp was held in Arbroath with around 30 young people from five church to receive some teaching from the American guest speaker. At the same time, another building team from the USA came over to do more building work in Dundee. Dr Sloop came for a fourth visit in August to meet the new Agape Polish Church in Dunfermline that have join the Church of God Scotland.

Sadly, the Emmanuel Church in Aberdeen disbanded earlier in the year. However, two new churches have joined us: the Agape Church in Dunfermline and the Living Impact Church in Dundee which means we have 20 local churches.

As a multi-cultural, multi-lingual, and multi-generation charity we recognize the importance of working together with all people groups to improve the quality of life through a true and genuine encounter with the Jesus of the Bible.

Financial Review

Brief statement of the charity's policy on reserves	As a result of the year 2023-2024, our charity held £35,323.48 on 31 st October 2024 in its bank account. Our charity's income for 2024-2025 was £109,042.05. Our charity's expenditure on activities and governance costs was £92,687.21, which left our charity with a balance of £16,354.84 and with the surplus of £35,323.48 from 2023-2024, this has given us a new surplus of £51,678.32, however, most of this surplus £39,357.22 is restricted funds leaving only £12,321.10 as unrestricted funds. The charity also has assets for 11 Dens Road Dundee that are of an estimated value of £142,349, and 2a Carrick Road Glasgow £100,000. Therefore, these funds will enable our charity to continue to meet its running costs for the next financial year (November 2025 to October 2026).
Details of any deficit	It is the policy of the charity that unrestricted funds which have not been designated for special use should be maintained at a level equivalent to between three months' expenditure. The Trustees consider that reserves at this level will ensure that, in the event of a significant drop in funding, they will be able to continue the charity's current activities while consideration is given to ways in which additional funds may be raised. This level of reserves has been maintained throughout the year. However, 80% of the charity's income is now from the USA.


Other optional information
