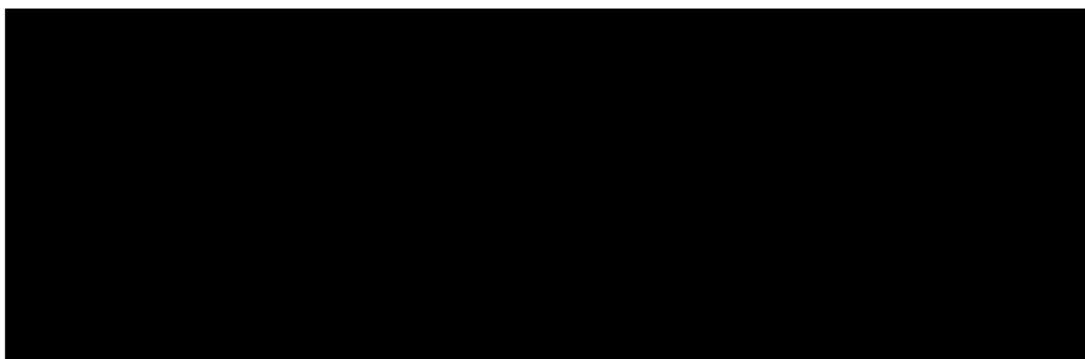
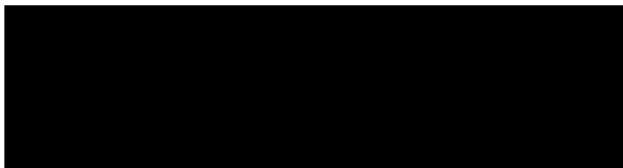

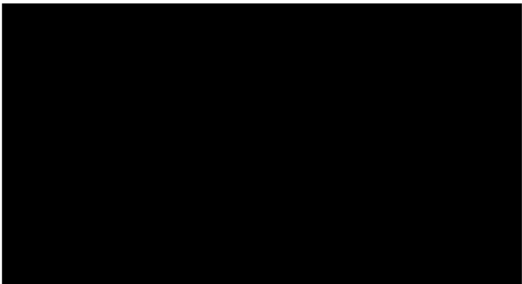

Structure, governance and management

We're governed by a two-tier constitution. We're a small organisation; the maximum number of trustees is 5.

Trustee recruitment and appointment

"At each AGM, the members may elect any member (unless they are debarred from membership under clause 57) to be a charity trustee.

The maximum number of charity trustees is 5 ; out of that:

54.1 no more than [5] shall be charity trustees who were elected/appointed under clauses and 60 (or deemed to have been appointed under clause 58); and

54.2 no more than [5] shall be charity trustees who were co-opted under the provisions of clauses 63 and 64.

55 The minimum number of charity trustees is [3]."
