## Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

During the year, the charity produced and promoted a contemporary concert prepared and produced by entitled, "From Lockdown To Limelight". The production proved a success in terms of the society's objectives but resulted in a small deficit, with total income amounting to £7,847 and with associated and future costs of £9,655, a deficit of £1,808 arose. However, this was offset by donations and grants. A donation of £500 was received from the Bo'ness Real Ale Appreciation Society, £100 was received from Caledonian Produce and other donations amounting to £578 were received from private individuals to assist with the cost of the production.

However, fund-raising activities raised total receipts amounting to £582 to set against the production deficit. There were no associated costs attributable to fund raising activities.

#### Financial review

Brief statement of the charity's policy on reserves

The unrestricted funds represent income earned but not yet utilised in supporting charitable activities. At 31 March 2022 the charity held £6,356 at the bank and cash and the Trustees consider this to be appropriate to meet initial costs of the proposed production.

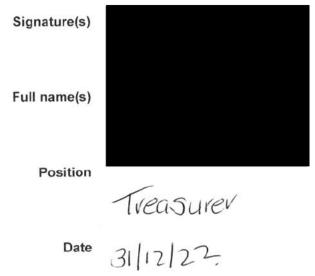

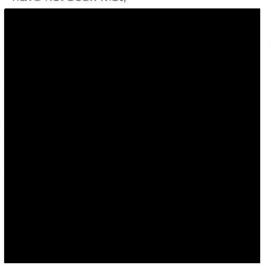
