Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

Mama Biashara has been able to continue and expand our work in Kenya. As you will see from the spreadsheets, the shop is continuing to do well and we are accruing a few more sizeable donations.

The numbers of groups we are rescuing, relocating and setting up in businesses are increasing. Added to which, our groups, once established and expanding, become part of the funding process themselves – setting up new groups without requiring extra money from Mama B. This is a huge achievement.

According to the reciepts we have, in the last financial year counting business grants alone, we set up businesses for 3000 adults (90% women) who between them have 6500 children.

Our focus is still on rescuing women and girls from sexual / domestic/tribal abuse, forced early marriage, FGM and forced prostitution.

However our outposts in Cheptulu and Awendo are more about relieving extreme poverty. Our Raincatchers in Western have more or less wiped out waterborne disease and our nutritional supprt in both areas is very important. We still support DECIP and, to a lesser extent the Mary Faith Centre. We are also still providing much needed nutritional support in some areas, treat for ringworm and intestinal worms and donate colostomy bags to a local organisation.

The shop is doing very well and we have many regular customers and a growing reputation as 'the' place to go for African fashion. We still feel that having the shop as our primary source of funding is a good choice. It helps both the local dressmakers and the main charity beneficiaries. And it gives us independence.

We look forward to the new year.

Financial review

Brief statement of the charity's policy on reserves

The charity has no running overhead costs (no salaries, property costs etc), all money raised goes to fund our charitable objectives in Kenya, so there would be no wind up costs and there are no fixed financial commitments. Thus the reserves policy is to keep 5% of annual income in reserve so that the maximum support is going out in fulfilling our charitable objectives.

Donated facilities and services (if any)

The W12 Shopping Centre in London, provide a shop unit free of charge, W12 is run by W12 Investments to whom we are eternally grateful. British Airways waive 10 bags for each trip from Kenya. This enables the running of the shop at a decent enough profit to fund the work of the charity. Most recently they have also allowed two free bags on the outward leg of the journey

APPENDIX 1

Other optional information

Having found, over time, that one of the best 'start up' businesses we have is the selling of donated bras, we now have a well developed network of 'bra donors' across the UK. This means, of course, that the financial outlay for many groups is only for transport away from their 'danger zone'. This is a small but very important step. It also allows people who cannot afford to donate money, to engage with the work of Mama B. Currently the main income of the charity comes from the Mama Biashara Shop which is in London. It offers a triple whammy of use 1) fundraising 2) awareness raising 3) being a huge benefit and support in income to many subsistence level craftpeople and artisans in Kenya, whose work is what we sell.
