Structure, Governance and Management

The Squadron is a charitable body whose purposes and administration arrangements are set out in its constitution.

All trustees are elected and appointed at the AGM held annually.

Objectives and activities

The charity's purpose is to educate teenagers in aviation studies, encourage them to take part in team activities and sports and help them develop into responsible adults.

The cadets take aviation exams and participate in various sporting and team building exercises. They engage in public relation tasks such as marshalling races and other events.

Achievements and performance

During the above period, the charity provided this programme to 64 cadets.

This year 875 (Westill) squadron has provided training to approximately 60 cadets, ages ranging from 12 to 18 years and included subjects such as leadership, STEM, cyber & communications and first aid. The squadron has also offered cadets opportunities for air experience flying & gliding, camps and a wide range of courses to develop their skills. One of our cadets was chosen to attend the Battle of Britain memorial tour to mark the 85 anniversary of the end of World War 2.

Several cadets have enrolled in the Duke of Edinburgh's Award scheme with a number beginning their Bronze award, one achieving their silver and one completing their Gold Expedition. The cadets have also participated in a number of competitions at local and regional level and volunteered at a number of local community events.

Financial Review

The charity's main income is subscription income. The charity aims to hold sufficient cash funds to meet all expenditure due and anticipated during a 2 month period.

No remuneration or expenses were paid to Trustees during the year.

During the above period the charity had a surplus of £1,909.28
