



This is the annual report for the 2025-26 fiscal year.

In our WoGI Switzerland account, we started the year off owing CHF 25,680.60 and ended the year with CHF 14,097, which is a net loss of CHF 11,583, which is the payment directed toward SITA tanks for our Madagascar debt.

In our WoGI Scotland accounts (GBP, Euros, USD, CAD) our net assets began at £1952.52 and we closed with £1350.87. The 601.65 was directed to WoGI Switzerland to add to the payment toward our Madagascar debt.

During this fiscal year we spent approximately \$300 to purchase vanilla pods from Madagascar which were brought to France with my hosts from Antananarivo, and sent to my friend in the South of France. We're waiting for a final count, but it's coming to approximately €2000 according to scratchy calculations. All this money has been directed toward repaying our debt. We have one more batch waiting for us in France which will be sold to the same end (debt repayment).

Thus far, the Mozambique project hasn't taken too much form. It's been challenging to get clear numbers, but from what I've got so far I'm estimating that we'll be paying approximately \$200/tank if we purchase them in Mozambique and transport them to Quirimba by boat. I'm also looking into purchasing the tanks in Tanzania and sailing them down to Mozambique. In either case we'll need to sail them to the destination and at the moment finding a price for suitable transport is not clear.

We have two friends who are doing projects to help with our Mozambique project, which is very encouraging!

We now have two new monthly donors in Canadian funds, and since last year, two in GBP. The amounts seem small, but are making a substantial difference as they faithfully land each month. We have one person who's been giving an amount on a weekly basis (making it comfortable for him) which has been a huge blessing over the past year. I'm gently trying to encourage people who don't have much to work with, to give a small amount on a weekly basis so that it doesn't feel too heavy at the end of the month..
