Structure, governance and management

Type of governing document

The entity is a Scottish Charitable Incorporated Organisation named St Lawrence Hall, Old Rayne. It is governed by its constitution

Trustee recruitment and appointment

At each Annual General Meeting the members of the SCIO may elect any member of this SCIO to be a trustee. Trustees for 2025 were appointed at AGM on 3rd September 2025 and office bearers were appointed in Ordinary Meeting on 29th October 2025.

Objectives and activities

Charitable purposes

The purpose of the St Lawrence Hall, Old Rayne SCIO is to provide recreational facilities for the residents of the village of Old Rayne and its surrounding district to enable individuals, clubs and other organisations to enhance community spirit, promote social inclusion/interaction and deliver a diverse range of leisure and other community-based activities.

Summary of the main activities in relation to these objects

The organisation raises funds for the local community and its village hall mainly by organising the annual Lourin Event in the village's St Lawrence and other occasional fundraisers. There were also two Pub Nights to raise funds. These funds contribute to the upkeep of the St Lawrence Hall to allow this hall to be made available to organisations and the local primary school without costs other than electricity used by these groups. The organisation may elect to offer small grants to local organisations applying for funding through that this not happen during 2025. The organisation usually provides a Seniors' Xmas lunch during the month of December for retired villagers and their partners, though, again, that did not take place, but it is hoped it will be resurrected. In addition, we are now charging the Old Rayne Preschool for use of the premises which brings in funds

Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

We held the Lourin BBQ and duck race which raised £2530.

We held a pub night in April which raised, and one in October which raised £843.

We also rent out the St Lawrence Hall for parties – there are usually children's parties. This year these raised £96.

The committee decided to start charging the Old Rayne Playgroup for the use of the hall from August. This raised £2780.

We also received £1580 rebate from Scottish Power because they had overcharged us in 2023/24.

We managed to obtain a maintenance grant of £1991 from Aberdeenshire Council. This restricted fund will be used to purchase new kitchen equipment and various resilience items in 2026.

A villager raised £500 through the Kiltwalk, who volunteered her efforts to raise these funds.

Financial review

The organisation will hold sufficient funds for any emergency repairs and for the maintenance of the St Lawrence hall as a community facility provision. We would aim to hold £20k of funds for these reasons.

The organisation makes the St Lawrence Hall available to organisations for the charitable purposes detailed above. Old Rayne Preschool uses the St Lawrence Hall during the academic year and Old Rayne School uses the hall for PE and any performances and events.
