The principal charitable purpose is the advancement of animal welfare.

The charity's aim is to raise funds within the United Kingdom which will then be provided to a registered charity in South Africa and used to provide positive solutions to help rescue, rehabilitate and rehome abandoned, abused and misunderstood dogs in South Africa.

During this financial year we opened a PayPal account and registered for PayPal giving. We registered as a charity with Donr, a digital fundraising solution for charities. We are registered as a charity partner on Easy Fundraising, an online platform where retailers pay a percentage of qualifying purchases to BarkingMad UK SCIO. We also have a Facebook page to promote our fundraising efforts. No payments have been received yet from these platforms, but there are payments pending with Easy Fundraising.

The charity's main income is expected to be grants and donations.

The charity has received donations totaling £0.01 this financial year. These funds remain in the Bank of Scotland account with the £175 carried forward from the last financial year as the cost of transferring such a small amount to South Africa is prohibitive.

No remuneration was paid to Trustees during the year.

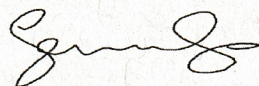

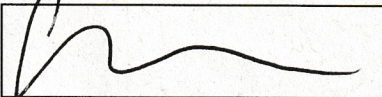
