- consultations with Aquarium staff and architect about the plans for Aquarium development;
- funding application to equip the new Learning Room within the new plans for the Aquarium.

Financial review

Brief statement of the charity's policy on reserves

FOMMA seeks only to maintain a positive balance to cover routine operating costs, or as saving for future projects.

The large donation received at the end of the last accounting period has been allocated as a Restricted Fund, and the monies will be placed in an interest bearing account pending the ability to use the funds in line with the donor's wishes; the donor is aware that due to the planned Aquarium refurbishment the funds are likely not to be used for perhaps another two years. Gift Aid was claimed and paid.

Details of any deficit

This year resulted in a relatively substantial surplus. As in last period report this was considered inevitable in view of the Aquarium closing in the autumn of 2024 for refurbishment, and therefore there was no purpose in upgrading features for visitors. Some funds, together with a grant applied for, have been tagged for equipping the future Learning Room.

All the Trustees and some of the members have freely given their time and effort to support the activities of FOMMA.
