5. **PRESIDENT'S REPORT :** President Denis Casey gave his annual report and commented on another successful season for the Club. Membership stood at 75, including 25 social members. 6. **TREASURER'S REPORT :** Annual Accounts had been distributed prior to the meeting. Treasurer C.Montgomerie was not present but the President stated on his behalf that bar-takings had been down 15% in the past year, whilst stock was increasing in cost. The profit-margin was around 46% however. Increases in bar prices and/or charges for hiring the lounge were discussed, but no decision on either was taken. A further grant of £6000 had been obtained from the Stirling & Clackmannan Environmental Trust , to be spent on new flooring and replacement banking. The Tuesday café had reopened and had made a profit of around £1000. The President thanked the Treasurer for his hard work on behalf of the Club, and also V.P Ian Cameron for his work in obtaining the grant.
