Constitution

The Charity is an unincorporated association and was granted charitable status by OSCR on 4th December 2015.

Appointment of Trustees

The Charity's Trustees and Committee members form its Management Committee which normally meets on a monthly basis. Membership of the Management Committee is open to all Putting Green Volunteers.

Trustees are elected at the Annual General Meeting. There must be a minimum of three and a maximum of eight.

2025 Season Highlights

- ♦ The Putting Green opened on Saturday 5th April 2025 for a 28 week season, closing on 19th October.
- ♦ Our annual Egg Hunt took place on 20th April this year and was very popular once again. We received approximately 40 children hunting for many, many eggs and were lucky to have 52 visitors putting. We raised £80 on the day from fundraising. This money covers the cost of chocolate eggs and bags.
- ♦ Our Donations Box raised £380.
- ♦ Visitors numbers for the season were 4105.

Volunteers & Visitors

- ◆ We have maintained our volunteer numbers at 15, which is great, with 1 new volunteer and one unavailable due to illness. We aim to advertise via the local magazine and social media for more volunteers for the 2026 season. Covering the 7 day opening through July, August and early September will be easier with more people.
- ◆ We continue to thank and celebrate our volunteers with an end of season dinner and regular coffee meets ups during the closed season.
- ◆ We received a total of 4105 visitors in 2025 with July our busiest month with 1180. The spring holiday in April also brought 701 visitors.
- ◆ Visitor numbers increased approximately 12.5% on 2024, mainly due to the much better summer weather. Although we are still below the 4581 in 2023 but if we can maintain 4000 annually we will be pleased.



Financial Overview 2025

- ◆ Our Income from Trading was £11,867 a healthy increase of over £4000 on 2024. This is in part due to our price increases to putt, the first since 2014.
- ◆ Expenditure increased £1071 on the previous year but we had a surplus for the year of £2253.
- ◆ Our income from PKC for the Comfort Scheme was £770, an increase of £70.
- ◆ We received £380 in donations.
- ◆ We made a donation of £1000 to Dementia Friendly Aberfeldy, a wonderful local initiate who hold a weekly dementia club with crafts, singing, lunch, gardening and story telling.

Looking Forward to 2026

- ◆ Continue to engage with the local community and make the Putting Green available to groups wishing to hold events.
- ◆ Advertise and actively try to recruit more volunteers via social media, notice-boards, local magazines.
- ◆ Hold our annual Egg Hunt during the Spring Break.
- ◆ Meet as a group regularly out of season as well as during.
