The reserve levels are considered during the end of each session (year).

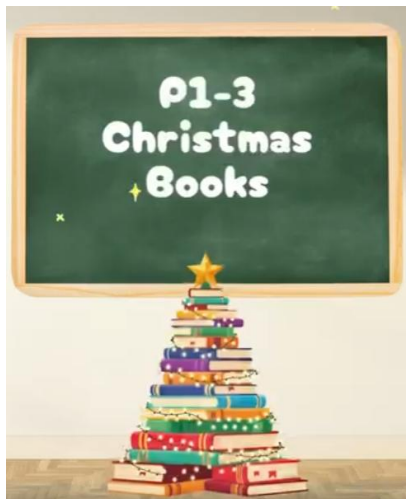
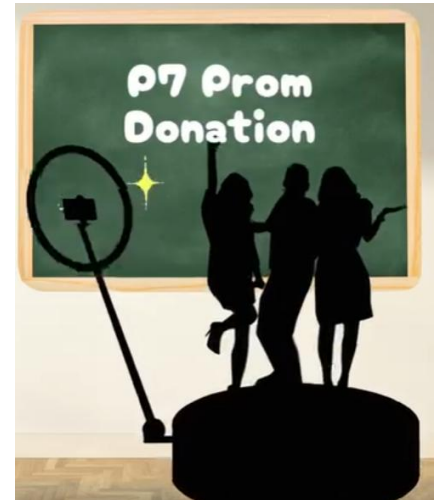
They are selected to cover the expenses up to and including the busiest month for the Parent Council – December.
