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Objectives and Activities

Craigie Tweenies Toddler Group was established to provide a safe, welcoming, and inclusive environment where babies, toddlers, and their parents, carers, and families could meet, play, learn, and build friendships within the local community.

The group held one session each week, offering age-appropriate toys, play activities, and opportunities for social interaction. The group aimed to reduce isolation for families, encourage children's development through play, and provide peer support for parents and carers.

Achievements and Performance

During the reporting period, approximately 10 local families attended the weekly sessions.

The group continued to provide a valued community space where young children could play safely while parents and carers developed supportive relationships with one another. The trustees are grateful to the volunteers and families who contributed to the success of the group throughout its operation.

Due to declining attendance and our venue being sold, the trustees made the difficult decision to close Craigie Tweenies Toddler Group in March 2025.

Financial Review

The trustees managed the charity's finances responsibly throughout the reporting period, ensuring that funds were used solely to support the charitable objectives of the group.

Following the closure of the group in March 2025, the remaining assets and funds have been managed in accordance with the charity's governing document and the requirements of the Office of the Scottish Charity Regulator (OSCR).

Structure, Governance and Management

Craigie Tweenies Toddler Group was managed by a voluntary committee of trustees responsible for the overall governance and administration of the charity. Trustees were appointed in accordance with the charity's constitution and met regularly to oversee the operation of the group, financial management, and compliance with charity law.

The group relied on the support of volunteers to deliver its weekly sessions and manage the day-to-day activities of the charity.

Plans for the Future

As the charity ceased operating in March 2025, there are no plans to resume activities. The trustees will complete the remaining administrative requirements associated with the closure of the charity.

Trustees' Responsibilities

The trustees are responsible for preparing the Trustees' Annual Report and financial statements in accordance with applicable law and the charity's governing document. The trustees confirm that they have complied with their duties under Scottish charity law in administering the charity and managing its resources in furtherance of its charitable purposes.
