Objectives and activities

Wee County Crafters provides a space for members of the community to take part in woodworking and other crafts. The facilities include woodturning lathes, bandsaws, workbenches, a carving room, a pyrography room, scroll saws, and a wide array of other equipment.

Achievements and performance

Wee County Crafters had a successful year of activity and community engagement.

The club held successful open days in both spring and autumn, attracting many visitors from the local area and helping to raise awareness of the club within the community.

The club was awarded a grant from the EDF Burnfoot Fund, which was used to upgrade the dust extraction system. This has improved the workshop environment by making it cleaner, quieter and safer for members.

The club made further investment in its facilities and equipment, replacing outdated machinery including the large radial arm saw with a new mitre saw, improving the safety and suitability of the workshop for members.

The club contributed to the local community by donating a Tartan Day banner to the local Provost. A member also used their woodworking skills to carry out repairs to wooden play equipment at a local primary school.

Financial review

The organisation raised sufficient funds from members weekly dues and open day proceeds, along with a previous national lottery grant to maintain a comfortable financial position.
