The multisport pitch and small pavilion are well used by a variety of local clubs and groups as well as individual hires for birthday parties etc. The local Primary School (next door) uses the pitch for PE lessons when appropriate as well as the Active Schools programmes, free of hire cost, in support of creating low cost sporting opportunities for local children. The pitch is always open to the public for casual use and is very well used and looked after by the community.

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Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

The multi-sport pitch and pavilion continued to be well used by local sports clubs, groups, the local Primary School and for birthday parties. Long term lets continue for Gullane Athletic AFC, Gullane Hockey Club and the local netball club, the Bass Rocketeers. When the pitch is not booked, it remains a popular option for local kids and teens to play.

The Operating Committee continue to do a fantastic job, overseeing the day-to-day running of the facility which includes bookings, invoicing, minor repairs and servicing of floodlights and other maintenance.

The Trust continues to support the Local Council regarding the re-development of the sports field, amenity land and playpark.
