Through the year we have continued to have a great place for the children to have fun. We meet at Auchinairn Community Centre every week day from 9.45am to 12.45pm. We have social play every day and at the end of each day we have song time and bubbles. We have had a wide variety of things for the children to do. We have a bouncy castle, trampolines, scooter, bikes, prams, sand and lots of educational toys. We offer a great variety of healthy snacks each day, we also have Jo Jingles every month which the kids love. We have had Easter, Halloween and Christmas parties through the year. We also have summer and Christmas trips each year. We have had two grants from East Dunbartonshire Community Council to help with the costs of hall hire, Jo Jingles, the Christmas trip and providing fruit as a health snack. We also do fundraising activities to cover our other costs.
