# Structure, governance and management

#### Type of governing document

#### Constitution:

The Charity is a Scottish Charitable Incorporated Organisation (a SCIO). It was registered in its current legal form on 30 July 2018. The charity is governed by its constitution.

#### Trustee recruitment and appointment

The Trustees are recruited by the current board of trustees from the existing club membership as a need is identified.

There is a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 10 Trustees.

The Trustees form the board who hold regular meetings controlling the activities of the organisation and overseeing the subgroups and committees that help run the club. The Trustees can co-opt (max 7) new trustees during the year. Trustees are elected each year at the AGM.

# Objectives and activities

#### Charitable purposes

The organisation's purposes are:

To advance the public participation in the sport of basketball, through coaching and the availability of recreational and competitive opportunities.

To provide recreational activities and facilities, through the sport of basketball, to improve the lifestyles of those attending

# Summary of the main activities in relation to these objects

The charity provides opportunities for boys and girls starting with age group U8 through to U18, plus men and women from 18 upwards to participate in basketball coaching sessions suitable for their age group. Sessions run 7 days a week across 6 different venues.

Members can progress to participate in teams that take part in local league (Strathclyde), regional development and Scottish Championship leagues (SBC).

For the 2023/24 basketball season, the club continued all sections it had in 23/24 while reducing the number of teams in SBC but keeping the same number in SLBA.

## Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period The trustees continued to meet on a regular basis, with a mix of in-person meetings and Teams calls. The AGM was held in-person again this year. The 2024 Awards night format changed: instead of a full evening event with food, drink, raffle, entertainment and the awards, a cut-back format with squads attending the assembly hall at a fixed time. It was a good, but it is hoped that volunteers will step forward to run future annual awards nights in a format closer to how they had previously been. Congratulations to all players and volunteers who were presented with a 2024 award.

It was another strong year on court. In the SLBA cups, the club was represented in 2 of the 6 finals. The U16men retained the cup they won in 2023, while the U18men fell short in their defence of their cup, finishing runners-up. In the SLBA leagues it was an impressive 10 Ayr Storm squads competing (teams: 3 Senior Men, 1 Senior Women, 1 U18men, 3 U16men, 2 U14boys) across the 8 leagues. U16men Bolt won the Cadet Men league – making it a league and cup double for the U16men in 2023-24 SLBA season, repeating their feat of the 2022-23 season.

On the national stage, the club continue to be competitive in the Scottish Basketball Championships: The girls won the U16/18w div2 unbeaten with a 12-0 record. In respective div1s, U18men were mid table while both U16men and U14men were in the bottom groups as were SM in Div2. The U18m reached their Scottish Cup final and were runners up.

The Jr NBA program was run again for our younger age groups. As well as this, the CDO developed youth leaders and ran drop-in female basketball sessions. A successful Rising Storm program ran on Friday nights at the Citadel. Membership numbers again grew to record numbers. Available coaches capped growth, so a long waiting list remained in place.

#### Financial review

Brief statement of the charity's policy on reserves

This is year six of the club operating as a SCIO. The Trustees focus remained to ensure the reserves are in place to fund the CDO salary commitments as well as hall hires to run activities. We were in a healthy position with a bank balance that would allow full funding of the CDO post and facility hires even if there was an unexpected drop in income.

Membership growth increased income and this was tracked to ensure we would cover the increased costs associated with more hall hires and more competition entries without impacting the club funds.

# Other optional information

CDO post

The final instalment of the grant from SportScotland for a Club Development Officer post was received in 2022-23 financial year and ran to February 2024. With the ending of this grant, the Trustees having reviewed the club's financial status and the contribution the CDO role makes, made the unanimous decision to continue with the post that now has to be 100% funded through the club. We are pleased that Laura wished to remain in the post and continue the great work she has started. The focus will change, and the chair of the Trustees will continue to work with the CDO on objectives and measuring what is being achieved through the post.

#### Trustees:

One Trustee stepped down in August 2024 and we would like to put on record our thanks to Laura for her contributions, especially working with the supplier to get our Veo camera system and have it setup for squads to use. The decision was taken to continue with the current number of 3 Trustees until the opportunity occurred to complete the planned review of what sub-committees should look after the day to day operation of the club and let the Trustees Board support those and focus on medium to long term areas and adjust the frequency of Trustees meetings before considering recruitment.

We were pleased with how the new process for players to register themselves with BasketballScotland for the season instead of club doing bulk registrations, went. This reduced the workload for our stretched volunteer as well as eliminating an outgoing from the club income, effectively increasing our available cash without increasing fees.

Future Plans:

Season 2024-25 will see the club represented at just 4 (was 6 the prior season) of the national competition levels (1 female, 3 male) run by BasketballScotland. Their remains challenges to develop the female side, though this was not helped by the governing body BasketballScotland withdrawing a place for the clubs U14girls. The club withdrew the SBC SM entry due to lack of seniors wishing to play at this level and new rules mean we cant run it primarily with youth aged layers. Trustees continue to support the aims of the coaches, CDO and membership as best as can.

The CDO has again secured a Jr NBA program from BasketballScotland and this will again be aimed at our younger sections who don't have any regional leagues to be involved in.
