Who are we and what do we do!

We are a team of 24 volunteers who give our free time to manage and deliver the services at Buttons & Bows Baby Bank. We have 7 Trustees, 16 volunteers and an advisor to the board



Families can come and pick up their free baby essentials at Royal British House, Leonard Street, Perth. We are open Tuesdays 10am -12noon and Wednesdays 9.30am -11.30am. Referrals can be made through health professionals and agencies so families can have access to free nappies, baby food, baby wipes, baby toiletries and prams.

What's new at Buttons & Bows Baby Bank

In December 2023 our Co -Founder Alan Moore laid laminate flooring and we had new shelving built and fitted in our shop area, It looks fabulous!

Website: Our website was revamped this year by Jennifer Campbell one of our board members who worked with Lightpress to improve our website layout.



We are currently working in Partnership with Perth Citizen's Advice Bureau using the FORT system as a cross sector referral tool. We hope to further develop this system to enable us to increase our operational efficiency.

We were also awarded £1,500 from Asda's Under 18's Fund to help us buying nappies etc .



Our Impact

Impact generated by Baby Bank

Alliance :

Buttons & Bows Baby Bank gifted a value of £526.107 to 1,254 families. This amount to an average saving of £420 per family.

For families, this saving equates to

3months of energy bills for an average 3 bed household or over 3weeks of grocery shopping for a 4 person household.

The environmental impact of the 3,100 items gifted (excluding clothes bundles) saved approximately

1.2tonnes of carbon dioxide.


This is the same weight as a Hippopotamus and a saving equivalent to a person being on a plant based diet for one and a half years.

Over this financial year we supported 1,582 families


