Structure Governance and Management

The Charity is an unincorporated association. It is governed by its constitution which was adopted on 21st December 2021

Constitution

The association granted charitable status by OSCR in January 2022

Appointment of Trustees

The management committee, which normally meets on a monthly basis, are the charity's trustees. Membership of the management committee is open to all women including trans women and non binary adults. Trustees are elected at the Annual General Meeting which is normally held in December. There must be a minimum of three and not more than nine elected trustees. The trustees are responsible for the strategic direction and governance of the charity and donate their time to the charity.

Charitable purposes

Digital Din creates free workshops and resources in Sound Production and the Recording Arts for women (trans and non-binary inclusive) in particular those whose opportunities may be otherwise limited due to poverty or other disadvantages.

(a) To educate girls and women (trans and non-binary inclusive) in Scotland whose opportunities may be otherwise limited due to poverty or other disadvantages, by providing training courses in sound production and the recording arts. We have three purposes "the advancement of education", "the advancement of the arts, heritage, culture or science", "the relief of those in need by reason of age, ill-health, disability, financial hardship or other disadvantage"

Activities

Digital Din has designed a sound reinforcement workshop curriculum and applied for funding from Scottish Lottery for a series of workshops planned for November 2026 and February 2027 in Glasgow.

Our research this last year concerned; health and safety protocols and adult safe-guarding policy making, how to share information on social media, how to gain free software licenses for workshops, and how to create an e-learning course in sound production to have available during workshops. We also researched having a pay what you can/pay it forward membership and having a donation button for our website.

We had the pleasure of meeting with members of several well established sound production networks in England and the US and gained experience and information on mentorship, making funding applications and how user licenses and accredited certification from developers and hardware-software creators of sound production tools can be accessed/subsidised.

Digital Din trustees and members met regularly to discuss and organise research, share knowledge and support each other with sound production projects.

Achievements and Performance

Digital Din supported one of our members to attain training and certification in a specific sound production skill who then shared this knowledge with our members. Two of our members attended a workshop where they gained experience of field recording techniques, microphones and recording equipment. They connected with professional sound women and had a very enjoyable weekend.

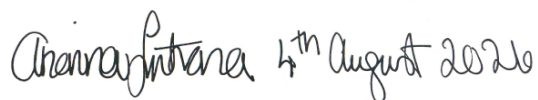
Plans for Future Periods

Plans are underway for a series of workshops in Sound Reinforcement at the Glad Cafe in Glasgow. Digital Din are currently undertaking research in how; sound walks encourage greater awareness of environment and climate, soldering and how to build microphones for a future workshop. We are currently making connections with organisations in Glasgow to advertise for cohorts for our planned workshop in November and our members plan to attend and shadow facilitators of a workshop in Yorkshire.

Financial Review
