The trustees are please to present their report and the accounts of the Diaspora Family Support for the year ended 31 July 2025. The accounts have been prepared on a receipts and payment basis, in accordance with accounting regulations for Scottish charities.

Structure, Governance and Management

The Diaspora Family Support is constituted as a Scottish Charitable Incorporated Organisation (SCIO), governed by a constitution and registered as a Scottish Charity (ref: SC052714) on 27 July 2023.

Charitable purposes

The Charity was set up to relieve the needs of people disadvantaged by the experience of Diaspora in Scotland by promoting and providing access to supportive counselling services. Promoting such other services as the trustees may consider furthers the purposes. Working in partnership with other bodies to achieve the purposes.

Activities and achievements

In line with the above objectives, as a charity, we have been able to support three families through working with them as they support their struggling children. We are currently continuing to work with the schools and the families to support the children and families through their challenging times. Diaspora Family Support has worked in collaboration with Aberdeen Women's Group Scotland to increase its support base to the affected families. As a charity, we have supported some couples in their bid to settle into the community as they try to understand the new community they have arrived into. We have worked with one of the universities to support the new students who have arrived in Scotland.

While we have not raised any funds to date, the amount spent in the account has been privately funded by individuals in the leadership. We look forward to greater impact in the coming year.

Report of the Independent Examiner

To the Trustees of the Diaspora Family Support

I report on the accounts of the **Diaspora Family Support** (the Charity) for the year to 31 July 2025, which are set out on pages 7 to 8.

Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the terms of the Charities and Trustees Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006. The charity trustees consider that the audit requirement of Regulation 10(1)d of the Accounts Regulations does not apply. Basis of independent examiner's statement

My examination is carried out in accordance with Regulation 11 of the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts, and seeks explanations from the trustees concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit, and consequently I do not express an audit opinion on the view given by the accounts.
