#### Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustees of The Arndee Trust

I report on the accounts of the charity for the year to 5<sup>th</sup> April 2024 which are set out on the previous pages.

### Respective responsibilities of Trustees and Examiner

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the terms of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006.
