Trustee recruitment and appointment

The charity operates as a Two Tier SCIO with Trustees being appointed by Members at AGM.
The Trustees may appoint additional Trustees as per the constitution.

Objectives and activities

Charitable purposes

**The advancement of public participation in sport (cycling).
The provision of recreational facilities, or the organisation of recreational activities, with the object of improving the conditions of life for the persons for whom the facilities or activities are primarily intended.**

Summary of the main activities in relation to these objects

The organisation ran regular sessions providing young people from across Glasgow and the West of Scotland opportunities to access cycling activities across multiple disciplines.
Barriers were removed by providing access to appropriate bikes and safety equipment for those who didn't have their own.
Opportunities were also provided to encourage young people to race in a safe 'club confined' environment allowing them to experience what would happen at an event and during a race.
Subsequent opportunities to enter grass roots racing with riders from the wider community were provided in mountain biking and cyclocross racing.
To encourage participation in racing across all age groups, including volunteers, members were given the opportunity to earn a t-shirt or hoody for participating in 6 or 10 races respectively.
To take a group of young people away on a weekend camp.

Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

A total of 182 activities were held for club members including regular sessions and races:

- **Saturday groups**- 33 sessions held
- **Cross Life- club confined cyclocross race**- 14 session held
- **BMX**- 36
- **Track**- 36
- **Rollers and Fitness**- 27
- **Shredderz Mountain Bike Group**- 13
- **Road**- 19
- **Mountain bike Camp**- 1
- **Parklife- mountain bike dirt crits**- 3 races held

To help encourage grass roots participation in racing, Riderz Racerz 2025 provided an opportunity for members to be awarded a uniquely designed t-shirt or hoody. Those who raced 6 were awarded a t-shirt and 10 a hoody. A total of 36 Riderz, and volunteerz who were also encouraged to participate, entered at least 6 races.

- **10 races**- **31** riders received a hoody
- **6 races**- **5** riders received a t-shirt

A group of 16 Volunteers took 29 young people away on a weekend camp.

Financial review

Brief statement of the charity's policy on reserves

We will make all reasonable endeavours to hold sufficient reserves to cover at least 3 months expenses, but ideally closer to 6 months expenses, to help in the event it is unreasonable to charge membership fees because of an occurrence like Covid.

Our average monthly expenditure excluding events (which are roughly self financing) during last year was £2,583.
At the end of 2025 we had £15,505 in our Reserve Account and £4,390 in the general account.

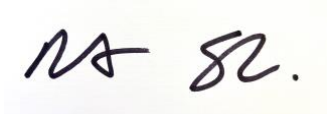
We intend to continue to invest in training of volunteers during 2026 so that we can deliver more charitable activity to more young people.

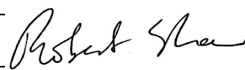

Section C Notes to the Accounts

C1 Nature and purpose of funds (may be stated on analysis of funds worksheets)

In 2025 our Income and Expenditure for Events was significantly lower as we organised less races. For 2025 Gross Trading Payments were Venue Hire of £6844 (£6510 in 2024), Events costs of £5520 (£9848 in 2024) & Supplies costs of £2,868.90 (£2734 in 2024). We submitted our first Gift Aid claim in 2025, receiving £5272 for donations received with we have Gift Aid consents for in 2024 & 2025, in future years we can expect to receive between £3000 to £4000 per annum. We invested £4195 in Equipment and finished the year with a healthy surplus of £2496. It is expect we will roughly break even in 2026 as we continue to invest in training staff and purchasing equipment so that we can support more young people to take part in cycling. We received grants towards cost of training already completed, we also received £1000 of Grant from WOSCA to be distributed as small grants for young people taking part in British National level cycling events (£50 for 1 day events & £100 for 2 days events up to a maximum of £200 per year). £300 of this funding was distributed as grants in 2025, leaving £700 available for future years. We sold a small number of club t-shirts at cost during 2025. We sold some kids Hybrid Bikes which we had no expectation of using during 2025. We received £500 Sponsorship from Highland Transfers, £300 from Dougall Baillie Associates & £1020 from Billy Bilsland Cycles as a deduction on an invoice for 2 new bikes. We received £1000 store credit from BD Print which was used to help fund the provision of the Riderz Racerz Hoodies & T-shirts (kids received a special Hoodie if they attended 10 races during the year or a T-shirt if they attended 6). Scottish Cycling Donated 16 Kids MTBs to us in April 2025.
