Running of weekly Gaelic classes for adult learners.

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Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

From August 2023 through to the middle of June 2024 we held a total of 34 Advanced classes online using Zoom and 34 Lower Intermediate classes at Sgoil Ghàidhlig Ghlaschu. The Advanced class worked largely with the short-story collection Eadar Dà Sgeul and with resources from BBC Bitesize, giving learners exposure to a variety of native speakers, as well as spending time in conversation. The Lower Intermediate class worked largely with Boyd Robertson's "Teach Yourself Gaelic", supplemented by exercises produced by the teacher, and focused on grammar and speaking.

We typically had around 14 regular attenders and a number of more intermittent attenders between the two classes.
