Structure, governance and management

Type of governing document

The Charity organisation became a SCIO on 2 December 2016. It is governed by its constitution which was last amended and adopted on 29 February 1996. The association was granted charitable status on 15 March 1985.

Trustee recruitment and appointment

The Management Committee shall consist of trustees appointed or reappointed by the members at an Annual General Meeting. In addition, the Management Committee shall have the power to co-opt additional members who shall be full or associate members of the Association.

Membership of the Association shall be open to:

- a) All persons living in Corstorphine and surrounding areas and they shall be called Full Members. Only those aged 18 or over shall be eligible to vote
- b) In addition, individual Association Membership shall be open to those people of 18 years of over who, in the opinion of the committee, shall further the aims of the Association and the community. Associate members shall have the same status as Full Members with the exception of clause 6(b).
- c) Any voluntary groups using the Associations premises who satisfy the management committee that their aims and objectives are similar to those of the Association and whose membership shall be of benefit to the Association.

Objectives and activities

Charitable purposes

a) To promote the benefit of the inhabitants of Corstorphine and surrounding areas without distinction of political, religious or other opinions by associating the Local Authorities, Voluntary Organisations and inhabitants in a common effort to provide facilities in the interest of social welfare for recreation and leisure time occupation and to advance education with the object of improving conditions of life for the said inhabitants.

The Association shall be non-party in politics and non-sectarian in religion.

Summary of the main activities in relation to these objects

To secure the establishment, maintenance and management of multiple premises for activities promoted by the association in furtherance of the above objectives.

Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

The Charity has seen a significant increase in activities following a new and re-energised board being appointed in November 2023.

Revenues increased to £35,655, including a £19,000 grant by the National Lottery towards the refurbishment of the local Community Centre.

Pitch hire revenue increased to £6,618, following significant spend on the Tall Oaks pitch itself (£4,073), as well as the surrounding perimeter (£6,127). Spend included works on felling and chipping trees, trimming of hedges and bushes, pitch drainage, fertiliser, grass seed and top dressing, and included many hours of volunteering by local groups and communities.

Spend on the refurbishment of the previously run-down and dormant local Community Centre amounted to c.£27,000 of which Corstorphine Dynamo Community Football Club (CDCFC) generously donated £4,255 towards, with the balance coming from the National Lottery grant, as well as surplus funds held by the Charity. The Community Centre is now used regularly by the local community for a whole host of different events and activities.

Following these undertakings, a decision was made by the Trustees in July 2024 to transfer all of the assets & liabilities held by the Charity to CDCFC.
