Objectives and activities

Charitable purposes

Our purpose is to advance the Christian faith.

We provide a facility for members of the local community where they can meet. Historically, as a church, and for over 25 years we provided a voluntary Childcare Group, which developed into full time provision of childcare by Coconut Corner Childcare Centre (SC038558) from 2008 to 2019. And the facilities are now used full time by Baillieston Community Church / Hope Community Church Barlanark (SC042804).

Summary of the main activities in relation to these objects

Baillieston Community Church / Hope Community Church Barlanark have a regular programme of activities for all ages, including Sunday Gatherings, Morning Bible & Prayer, Community Café, Baby and Toddler Group, and Bible Study.

Church Groups, Community Groups and families also make requests to use the hall for church services, funerals, events, and meetings.

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Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

In line with our purpose to advance the Christian faith, we have provided a facility for members of the local community to meet as a church over many decades and over the last 5 years enabling Baillieston Community Church (SC054231) and Hope Community Church Barlanark (SC042804) to have a regular programme of activities for all ages, including Sunday Gatherings, Morning Bible & Prayer, Baby and Toddler Group, Bible Study, and other community events.

The trustees decided the best way to advance the Christian faith in Baillieston going forward to sell our main building to Baillieston Community Church (SC054231) given our alignment in charitable purpose to advance the Christian faith and their potential to best serve the people of Baillieston in the coming years.

Given the purpose of both charities, the sale price would be nominal but include some financial safeguards over the next 10 years, following some legal advice. Over the next 10 years, it is likely that we (Baillieston Evangelical Church) would be working towards winding up.

Financial review

It is our policy to maintain sufficient reserves to meet our obligations as they fall due. The Trustees aim to have general reserves of at least three month's costs and review this policy periodically.

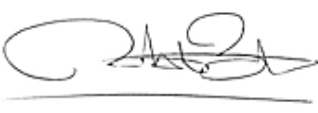
