TREASURER'S REPORT - 1ST OCTOBER 2024 - 30TH SEPTEMBER 2025

The opening balance for the Lossiemouth High School Parent Partnership for the year commencing 1st October 2024 was £3263.73.

This year our winter fundraiser was lucky numbers through our Facebook page again. We made £172 for the parent partnership and the winning number also received £172 as a prize.

We served teas and coffees at the Christmas fayre where we raised £24.50 and in June, we served teas and coffees at the P7 parents meeting which raised £5.81. It was a good opportunity to meet new parents.

Our Vice Chairperson was able to acquire funding from the Lossiemouth Bus Trust which we are very grateful for. They gave us £1476.82 of which we used £1160.93 towards the S2 IDL day out, a team building day at Lossiemouth east beach. We were able to purchase walkie talkies, den building kits, waterproof cameras and some fort building kits to assist with the evacuation to SolarPunk island after being shipwrecked. This was a great success.

We also received a very kind donation from the S6 prom committee of £80.00 which was the funds they had left over after their prom.

Through fundraising and our previous balance, we have been able to help support some groups in the school again this year by asking for bids to be placed by the departments. We were able to support the physics department by purchasing photogates which allow students to perform a number of experiments using model cars and tracks, the SFI department with wipeable clocks and new maths and English books. To support raising attainment C Gibson bid for some resources to help with maths and some novels to help with English.

£661.71 was given to school funds from the money raised from the colour run as it was agreed that we would split the money between the school and the parent partnership.

We were also able to support the school by contributing £520 for the bus for the rugby trip where 48 pupils and 12 staff were able to see Scotland play Italy in the Six Nations.

To assist with the running of the group we received a yearly payment from the Moray Council of £436.48.

Finally, the Interest added to our account for 2024/2025 was £28.35
