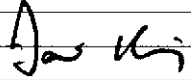

Independent examiners report
INDEPENDENT EXAMINER'S REPORT

TO the Trustees of Perth Indigent Old Women's Society SC004623

I report on the accounts of Perth Indigent Old Women's Society for the year ended 31 March 2026.

Respective responsibilities of Trustees and examiner

The charity's Trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the terms of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006.

The charity's Trustees consider that an audit is not required for this year under Regulation 10 (1) (a) to (c) of the 2006 Accounts Regulations and that an independent examination is needed.

It is my responsibility to:

- (i) examine the accounts under Section 44 (1)(c) of the Act;
- (ii) to state whether particular matters have come to my attention.

Basis of independent examiner's report

My examination was carried out in accordance with the general Directions given by the Charity Commission. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts, and seeking explanations from you as Trustees concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit and consequently no opinion is given as to whether the accounts present a "true and fair view" and the report is limited to those matters set out in the statement below.

Independent examiner's statement

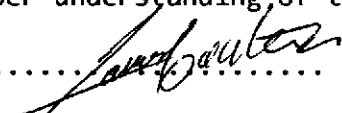
"In connection with my examination, no matter has come to my attention:
