No management decisions have been taken and no events have occurred after the year-end that have had, or may have, a material effect that requires further adjustment to, or disclosure in, the financial statements.

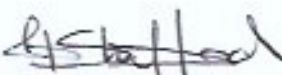
There are no instances of non-compliance with laws or regulations that are central to the operation of the charity's business.

All material transactions with related parties have been disclosed in the accounts.

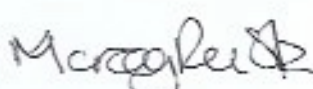
