About NappiRunz:

We believe Nappiness is a human right!

We've been up and running since 2016, and have been a registered charity since 2017.

Our model is simple. We collect clean, unused nappies in our NappiRunz branded bins, from community hubs like libraries, cafés and supermarkets. We then deliver them to partner charities and organisations such as food banks, women's shelters and refugee centres, for onward distribution to families.

From the start NappiRunz has always been - and will always be - an organic part of our local communities. So, it's vital to us that our team of passionate volunteers lives in and understands the areas we serve. We also know the importance of working closely with our partners, whether that's Crisis, NHS Health Visitors, or any of the incredible smaller charities we deliver to.

And this approach is working. NappiRunz has recently been honoured with a King's Award for Voluntary Service, the highest award given to volunteer groups in the UK.

Nappy need is a growing issue across Scotland, and we know from our work in communities that it's seriously underreported.

That's why we're working to start a national conversation about the difficulties families can face affording nappies. NappiRunz has been name-checked in Scottish Parliament, and we've discussed our work on local and national media including BBC Radio Scotland.

We won't stop until every child has enough clean nappies.

Our Charitable Purposes:

- The prevention or relief of poverty in the UK by providing nappies, baby essentials, grants, items and services to individuals in need and / or charities, or other organisations working to prevent or relieve poverty.
- To relieve financial hardship among refugees, asylum seekers, migrant workers and their dependants living in the UK by providing nappies, baby essentials, grants, items and services.
- The prevention or relief of financial hardship anywhere in the world by providing or assisting in the provision of nappies, baby essentials, grants, items and services.
- To prevent or relieve poverty through undertaking and supporting research into factors contributing to poverty, including factors relating to parents, babies and children, and the most appropriate ways to mitigate these.
