Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

We are a small run Parent Council who work together to organise fund raising events for our School community. We have organised and run a Christmas Fayre which was greatly attended by children, parents, carers and the wider community. Our Mothers Day, Fathers Day and Elfriges gift shops are also very well supported - this is where we find lots of gifts in the sales and wrap them up for the children to buy for £4. Giving the children a sense of accomplishment and pride when they pass onto family members.

These fundraisers along with many others have raised funds so we can support the School / Nursery to attend a whole School pantomime and summer trip bringing the costs down substantially for parents / carers.

As our School is in a poorer area a lot of our families struggle with day-to-day items. We are lucky enough to have a larder / foodbank where families can access essentials. This is mostly donations from the Big Hoose Project but also funding from the Tesco Tokens where we can buy more essential items for families / School Community to take. We have also helped some families with school clothes, shoes and household essentials.

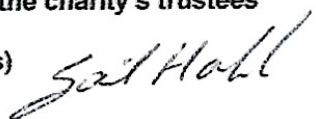
