The main achievement was maintaining the Unit in a stable operational and financial condition and provided growth opportunities both in terms of number of cadets and activities being offered.

Cadets' numbers have slowly increased, as a result income from donations has also increased.

Financial review

The biggest acquisition of the unit this financial year, has been a new(er) minibus, which will help the unit provide adequate transport for years to come.

The year has ended with a deficit of £-14,478.71, however, this includes the minibus purchase, for which we had £17,049.06 fund carried from previous years. This results in a net yearly surplus of £2,570.35. As previously agreed, when we increased the contributions, we have put aside £1,740 for the next minibus and £639 for the hardship fund, which results in a marginal net profit of \sim £200.
