Type of governing document	The Trust was set up by Ian and June Green and was recognised as a Scottish charity with effect from 28 September 2012. The Trust is administered in accordance with the terms of the Trust Deed.
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Trustee recruitment and appointment	The Trustees were those appointed on the establishment of the Trust and a Deed of Assumption and Resignation dated 6 and 8 February, 9 March and 30 April 2012, and represent the minimum number required. Appointment and removal is in accordance with the Trust Deed which requires that appointment is approved by unanimous agreement of the existing Trustees and removal of any Trustee by the unanimous agreement of the others.
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Objectives and activities

Charitable purposes	The purpose of the charity is for the advancement of the Arts heritage culture and science by preservation of recording of cultural and historical merit and by financial contribution or otherwise to the establishment of a Scottish National Sound Archive. To provide financial assistance for (i) young musicians to enable tuition and attendance; and (ii) those people within the Scottish Traditional Music scene whom the Trustees consider to be suffering from financial hardship. To support any charitable or other Trust having similar purposes.
