Following the OSCR and RDA UK advice on having a set of Voting Members, the Trustees set this up and we currently have 9 Voting Members.

Governing Document

Riding for the Disabled Association (hereafter referred to as RDA) was registered with the Charities Commission in October 1969 (Reg. Charity No. 244108) and became a company limited by guarantee (Company No.5010395) on 8 January 2004. RDA is a federation of 500-member Groups governed by a Membership Agreement with the national body (RDA National), the RDA Membership Manual and a Standard Group Constitution.

The Member Groups are all separately registered charities.

Charitable Purposes

The objects of the Group, as recorded in our constitution, are to provide the opportunity in the Deeside area for disabled people to ride to benefit their health and wellbeing, delivering a real and lasting therapy that not only benefits mobility and co-ordination but encourages confidence and self-worth while having fun.

We managed to hold nine sessions during the Summer Term 2023, eight sessions during the Autumn Term 2023 and three sessions during the Spring Term 2024. This was not as many as we would like to have held but there were some occasions when the Coach was not available due to holidays/personal development training. We have also had issues with Schools not being able to attend as they had no transport available.

Our main expenditure was £4,539. This was mainly made up of rental of ponies, arena hire and coaching fees along with the rental of a storage container for our equipment.

Our bank balance at the end of the year was £58,591.

Trustees remuneration and expenses

The trustees received no remuneration and no expenses during the year.

Reserves

No restricted funds were brought forward and all restricted donations during the year were utilised in full in accordance with instructions.

Reserves are modest and are held against any potential deficit in expenditure and to complete the planned building work.

Independent Examiners Report
