

THE KOLA'A TRUST

REPORT FOR THE YEAR TO 31st OCTOBER 2025

The Kola'a Trust was established in 1972 to regulate donations to religious and charitable bodies as directed by the Trustees.

The Trustees for the year were Mr Norman S.M.Berry, Mrs Sheila M.C.Berry, Mr David J.Berry, Mrs Ruth McKeever and Mr Andrew Berry.

During the year to 31st October the Trust had an income of Fifty Six Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty Four pounds and Twenty Two pence (£56,845.22)

A total of Fifty Eight Thousand pounds (£58,000.00) was distributed to various Charities resulting in a deficit of One Thousand One Hundred and Fifty Four pounds Forty Eight pence (£1,154.48) which was met from the Trust's reserves.

Over the years the Trust has supported a wide range of organisations with a strong emphasise on Overseas Aid and Medical charities. During the year the Trustees, as has been their policy, reviewed the pattern and level of support given to the various charities and agreed to continue the same general policy although they did agree . to the addition of a small number of new charities.
