- Continue to keep the local community updated on what we are doing and the range of events taking place in the hall.

What we achieved

➤ **Maintenance – internal and external**

The astro surface is in a poor state of repair due to flooding . We obtained costings for replacing the surface and investigated options . A questionnaire to seek views of the local community was compiled and circulated to all householders and feedback was given as part of the AGM held in April 2026.
