Annual Report 2023-24

The Royal Dornoch Foundation (Junior Golf) began its operations in 2023. Direct costs involved the rental of accounting software and the setting up of a bank account. The Foundation subsequently raised just over £13,022 in donations from members. Funds were used for transport, coaching and competitions both for Royal Dornoch Juniors and for those from Ardgay, Bonar Bridge and Portmahamock (these are listed in the accounts as “Travel and coaching-National”). A consultant was paid £2,000 to design a coaching pathway that will take juniors through the various stages of development towards elite levels of performance. The Foundation had a balance of £8,575 at the end of 2023/24 to be used for further coaching and competitions.

Overall, these activities provided a satisfactory start for the charity and the Trustees have agreed a forward plan for junior golf in Dornoch and the Dornoch Firth area.
