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# REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES FOR THE PERIOD 1 JANUARY 2021 TO 15 SEPTEMBER 2021

The trustees present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the period 1 January 2021 to 15 September 2021. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019).

### **OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES**

#### Objectives and aims

Our purposes as recorded in our constitution are:-

- b To promote, organise and carry out social and recreational activities with emphasis on family participation in connection herewith

In furtherance of the above, the Club will:-

- d Enter upon leases, sub-let and acquire heritable property and seek to raise loans in order to help finance any project relating to the courts, the clubhouse or any land in the club's lease and generally do all such things as are incidental or conducive to the continuance and development of such activities or the attainment of such objects.

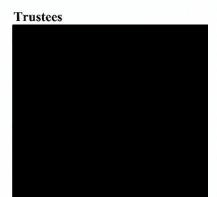

# INDEPENDENT EXAMINER'S REPORT TO THE TRUSTEES OF ROTHES TENNIS CLUB

#### Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner

#### Basis of the independent examiner's report

### NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE PERIOD 1 JANUARY 2021 TO 15 SEPTEMBER 2021

#### 1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

#### Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charity, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

#### Income

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

#### Expenditure

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

#### **Taxation**

The charity is exempt from tax on its charitable activities.

### Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.

### Hire purchase and leasing commitments

Rentals paid under operating leases are charged to the Statement of Financial Activities on a straight line basis over the period of the lease.
