The trustees who are also directors of the charity for the purposes of the Companies Act 2006, present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 31 March 2025. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019).

ACHIEVEMENT AND PERFORMANCE

Charitable activities

Fraserburgh Development Trust Ltd remains committed to supporting local organisations and the wider community within their operational area.

Despite the challenges encountered in the recent past, the Trust were pleased to be able to support charities and organisations on an ad-hoc basis by continuing to make available equipment, quick erect stalls, catering tables and a portable stage to assist local organisations in their fund raising efforts. The Trust, in conjunction with a local learning disability resource centre, also make available a range of accessible bikes which are stored securely - adjacent to the all purpose cycle track at the South Links Sports Trust facility.

The Community Garden, operated by the Trust, provides volunteering opportunities and a safe outdoor space for local organisations, including nursery groups, to acquire a greater knowledge of gardening. The volunteers, led by Bill Matthew, work hard to maintain and improve the facility and opportunities to further develop the garden continue to be assessed.

The educational shelter erected at the garden continues to provide groups and organisations the opportunity to enjoy the outdoors and its associated health benefits.

The Trust have recently adopted responsibility for managing and maintaining an existing CCTV installation in Fraserburgh town centre and are looking to enhance the CCTV provision.

The Trust, in conjunction with partner organisations, continue to develop a proposal to hold a Well Woman Fair in the town.

The management of the company is the responsibility of the directors who are elected and co-opted under the terms of the Memorandum and Articles of Association. New directors are briefed on their responsibilities and running of the Charity by existing directors.

None of the directors have any beneficial interest in the company. All of the directors are members of the company and have contributed £1 to be a member.
