Type of governing document

The Club is a charitable unincorporated association. It is governed by its constitution, in which are the purposes and administration arrangements. The organisation was registered as a Charity by the Inland Revenue on 25th October 1993.

Trustee recruitment and appointment

The Club's trustees are appointed or reappointed at the annual general meeting and can hold office for a minimum of 1 year. Members of the committee shall retire annually at the AGM but the committee shall have powers to co-opt and appoint should a vacancy occur during the year. The Sandwich Young Farmers Club is run completely by volunteers and the management committee meets regularly throughout the year. The committee continues to be strong and meetings are fully attended.

We also hold various fundraising events which enables us to carry on providing such activities.

We enter national competitions such as speech making etc. which enables our members to develop individually with various aspects.

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Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

The club has enjoyed another strong year of community engagement, fundraising & competitions.

The club had a strong showing at various Orkney district events such as the rally which is a great way to build relations with other clubs and likeminded people and the biennial concert competition.

We held an open stockjudding competition as a means to raise funds for the club.

We also organised a soup, supper & quiz night which raised funds and was a good way to include the community, as was our charity donation to MacMillan with these funds.

We held in-club fun events such as clay pigeon shooting, games nights and an isles trip to Shapinsay which was a great way to bond as a club.

It is the policy of the charity that unrestricted funds which have not been designated for a specific purpose should be maintained at minimum equivalent of six months expenditure. This level of reserves has been maintained throughout the year.
