

Trustees' Annual Report Year ended 31 December 2024 Structure, Governance and Management

Governing Document

The Church is administered in accordance with the terms of the Model Constitution. On 1st July 2024 Girvan North Parish Church, Girvan South Parish Church, Dailly Parish Church, and Barr Parish Church united to form Girvan Valley Church of Scotland and adopted the Unitary Constitution as encouraged by The General Assembly of the Church of Scotland.

Recruitment and Appointments of Trustees.

Members of the Kirk Session are the charity trustees of Girvan Valley Church of Scotland . The Kirk Session members are the elders of the four united Churches and were chosen from those members of the church who are considered to have the appropriate gifts and skills. We have had no minister since March 2019. The Interim Moderator and Locum were appointed by Presbytery on our union.

Organisational Structure

The individual Kirk sessions met several times separately during the first half of 2024 with the united Kirk Session meeting 5 times in the second half of 2024. It is principally responsible for the spiritual affairs within the church. Under the Unitary Constitution, we have various Action Teams to oversee the development of the church's affairs. Teams consist of elders and non elders who are members of the congregation. All business matters are discussed in the various Team meetings, then brought before the Kirk Session for approval. The Action Teams are:- 1. Fund Raising Activities. 2. Christian Education and Discipleship. 3. Pastoral Care. 4. Worship. 5. Outreach and Mission. There are also three supporting committees namely Fabric committee, Finance committee and Communications committee.

Objectives and Activities

The Church of Scotland is Trinitarian in doctrine. Reformed in tradition and Presbyterian in policy. It exists to glorify God and to work for the advancement of Christ's Kingdom throughout the world. As a national Church, it acknowledges a distinctive call and duty to bring the ordinances of religion to the people of every parish of Scotland through a territorial ministry. It co-operates with other churches in various ecumenical bodies in Scotland and beyond. In 2024 Public Worship of Almighty God was observed every Sunday at ll am in Girvan North/Valley and at 9:45am in Girvan South (up to end of June), while Dailly held services on the 1st, 3rd and 5th Sunday (where there was one) in each month with Barr holding services on the 2nd and 4th Sunday of the month all at 11am. Services were also held on a Wednesday morning at 10.30am in Girvan North/Valley except during the months Of July and August. There were teas, coffees and fellowship after each service. A large number of funerals were held in church during the year. Communion Services were held jointly with Girvan South, Dailly and Barr in March and June and then again in November (after the union), Our Locum, provided pastoral visits and telephone calls throughout the year, with the interim moderator of Girvan South and Barr provided pastoral care for these Churches up until the union. Services from Girvan North/Valley were live streamed each Sunday. Girvan North church magazine, North Star was delivered to members each month except July and August. It keeps members informed of church services and activities. Our church supports Christian Aid and Food Bank collections. During 2024 funds were raised for Malawi.

Girvan Valley Church of Scotland is a member of South Carrick Churches Together (SCCT). This is an ecumenical group of churches, including Girvan Methodist Church, the local Roman Catholic Church and Milestone Baptist Church. Outdoor services were held at Stumpy at Easter and at the harbour in July. Organisations, including a Parent and Toddler Group meet every Tuesday morning. On a Sunday during worship, there is a Primary Sunday School for children aged from 3 years old to S1 in both Girvan Valley and Barr Churches. The lst Girvan Boys Brigade Company meet in the Girvan Valley church hall every Sunday evening September to May. Girvan Valley News is now delivered to all homes 3 to 4 times a year.

Financial Review.

This is quite a difficult thing to write as for the first half of the year we were four separate Churches, however for the second half of the year we became one Church operating over three worship sites, with the main Church (Girvan North/Valley) meeting every Sunday and the other two on alternate Sundays.

The principal source of income of the church is through offerings, these are made up four main offering streams namely (a) Faster pay/Standing orders paid monthly by members directly into the Church bank account. (b) by using numbered offering envelopes put into the offering plate weekly where how much someone is putting in is anonymous and is only available to the person administering the gift aid list. (c) by direct cash donations into the offering plate. (d) by annual/biannual cheques paid directly usually via the treasurer. Other sources of income are lets of the Church Halls to various external organisations, and donations from Church organisations using the halls. Overall all 4 Churches had a joint income of £143246 (2023 - £120247) and a joint expenditure of £180807 (2023 – 123389). This expenditure includes the sum of approximately £27000 spent on a revamp of Barr Church.

It is the trustees policy to hold reserves of approximately six months normal outgoing expenditure. At the year end the Church held unrestricted funds of £183985. This relates to slightly over a years expenditure.

Statement of Trustees Responsibilities

The Members of the Kirk session must prepare financial statements which give sufficient detail to enable an appreciation of the transactions of the Church during the year. The members of the Kirk session are responsible for keeping proper accounting records which, on request, must reflect the financial position of the Church at that time. This must be done to ensure that the financial statements comply with the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005, the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006 and the Regulations anent Congregational Finance approved by the General Assembly of the Church of Scotland in 2007. They are also responsible for safeguarding the assets of the Church and must take responsible steps for the prevention and/or detection of fraud and other irregularities.
