Membership of the Association is open to individuals living and/or working in the area of benefit, and to others from outwith the area of benefit, who support the objects of the Association and who participate in the work of the Association, on payment of such fees and annual subscriptions as may be determined by the Association in General Meeting.

Governing document

St Brides is an unincorporated charity - No. SC 013166. The Charity maintains a constitution which details their objectives and activities of the centre.

Charitable purposes

The purpose of the charity is to provide the community of St. Brides with a facility for education, meeting and leisure activities and is open to all local groups and residents.

Activities and achievements

The St. Brides Community Education Centre provided education and film and theatre leisure activities.

The overall activities of St. Brides Community Education Centre Association generated a deficit at the year end of £4,513.

Trustee's remuneration and expenses

None of the trustees received any remuneration in respect of their services and no expenses were re-imbursed to any of them.

Reserves

As a result of a deficit of £4,513 over the year, St.Brides Community Education Centre Association held reserves of £25,294 of which £24,861 were unrestricted funds. The Trustees' policy is to maintain reserves at around 3 - 4 months of normal running costs in order to meet commitments and to cover any unexpected expenditure. Reserves at the end of the year were £25,294 which is within the target range.



Independent Examiner's report to the Trustees of St. Brides Community Education Centre Association.

i report on the accounts of the charity for the year ended 31 March 2019 which are set out on pages 4 to 5.

Respective responsibilites of trustees and examiner

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the terms of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 ("the 2005 Act") and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006 (as amended) ("the 2006 Regulations"). The charity trustees consider that the audit requirement of Regulation 10(1) (d) of the 2006 Regulations does not apply. It is my responsibility to examine the accounts as required under section 44(1) (c) of the 2005 Act and to state whether particular matters have come to my attention.

Basis of independent examiner's statement

My examination is carried out in accordance with Regulation 11 of the 2006 Regulations. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with these records. It is also includes consideration of any unusual items of disclosures in the accounts, and seeks explanations from the trustees concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit and, consequently I do not express an audit opinion on the view given by the accounts.

Independent examiner's statement
