While raising money through our standard methods of putting on musical productions, many additional fundraising events were taken on my members to boost the fund raised even further.

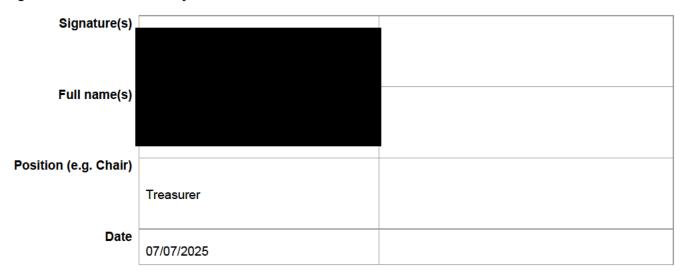
