Summer Camp (1 week) for 11-18 year olds carried out in July 2023 for 76 Boys and Staff. Plans underway for 2024 summer camp.

Bagpipe and Drum tutoring continued exceptional progress through the session. Links with Edinburgh Leith and District Pipe Band continue. Beating the Retreat at Edinburgh Castle successfully carried out again in May 2024.

New sports equipment funded, and additional Company Friday night meetings continued, aimed at health and exercise amongst 11-18 year olds.

3 young (18-26) staff members continuing roles at Battalion Level within the Brigade.

Community activities strengthened, increasing visibility in the local area.

Several members of the Company supported into higher awards and training as well as a continued focus on ensuring an inclusive approach for all members.

Overall focus on outdoor activities and Staff training continues to expand outdoor Kayak activities, Cycling and expedition all undertaken during the session.

New Company award and badge scheme successfully implemented and operating well.

The completion of works on our normal meeting place reaching an advanced stage with a high expectation of returning there in the coming session.
