## Structure, governance and management

#### Type of governing document

The Association is a charitable incorporated association whose purpose and administration arrangements are set out in our constitution.

The structure is one where the members elect a management committee each year and from these the key positions of chair, secretary and treasurer are elected.

### Trustee recruitment and appointment

The main activities in relation to our objects were providing horse riding lessons to less able bodied children and adults by our qualified British Horse Society Instructor.

#### Achievements and performance

## Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

Stranraer Happy Hooves RDA have continued to deliver riding and horse care sessions throughout the year. This has included our usual groups of riders as well as one-off sessions for Children and Family Social Work in the summer holidays.

We provided additional training for our regular riders to enable them to complete a dressage test, four of whom were were successful, which was a massive achievement. Rosettes were awarded to the participants and also to three participants who undertook horse care assessments.

Regular fundraising was conducted including two dog shows, one being our final show at Logan House, and we are very grateful to the Roberts family for allowing us to use this venue over the years. We also hosted bingo nights and a Christmas raffle, all of which contributed to help with our running costs.

Regular training is carried out by our coaches and volunteers, including therapy and medicine and a regional coaching conference.

We held a very successful volunteer recruitment day in May where we enlisted six new volunteers, which is a fantastic outcome for our small charity.
