The Embassy of the Word of God is a Charitable unincorporated association, and our purpose and administration arrangements are set out in our constitution.

Trustee recruitment and appointment

The trustees are appointed by the Senior Pastor of the Church to act in the interest of the trust. They serve for a minimum period of a year after which they are either reappointed or replaced by others.

Objectives and activities

Charitable purposes

The purpose of the charity is to advance religion in order to glorify God and manifest His character.

Summary of the main activities in relation to these objects

In the past 12 month we have continued with our weekly Sunday and Mid-week services to further the vision of the Embassy of the word of God (Edinburgh) which is to send the healing grace to our generation through the preaching of the word of God. Through these services we have been able to reach out to the university student group and have offered them various support in their education through counselling. Also, through our welfare department we have supported some students with material help. In the past 12 months we also managed to reach out to the people in the Wester Hails communities through our outreach programmes.

Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

During the year the charity received £143,146. Part of this has been saved with the rest being used to pay rent, car and other bills as outlined in our account. We also gave out honoraria to guest ministers who we invited for our special programmes throughout the year. Donations were also given out to members who were in need and others who dedicated their babies, married during the year. The church also provided financial support to bereaved families and other needs identified by the leaders of the church. Part of the funds was offered as humanitarian aid/assistance to support other churches and missionaries in Africa and India in their work with children and the elderly. This aid was set out in the payment account section as tithes. Overall, expenditure for the year was £140,720.

During the year we organised evangelism programmes and provided healing and counselling support for the people of Wester Hailes and its environs. As a result of our ongoing online activities, we have invested substantially in equipment and subscribed to various online services to broadcast our services to many both in the UK and globally. The Welfare department also supported many members by providing them with basic needs, such as groceries and financial support.

We have continued Our Life Classes training programmes during the year for the community and have extended it to the larger community of Edinburgh and Glasgow through an Edinburgh-based Christian radio station called Heartsong Christian Radio.

As part of the yearly programmes of our Men/Women Ministries we arranged various educational programmes online to help empower the men and women in the church and the people of Wester Hailes on life issues. Through our children ministry we also organised programmes for the children in the community. These were done through summer camps and children's day activities which were patronised by the children in the community as well as those in the church.
