The aim of the Charity is to improve the physical, emotional, social and spiritual wellbeing within the local community.

Summary of the main activities in relation to these objects

The charity operates both a Befriending Service for elderly residents within the community and Dementia Cafes across 4 venues in Aberdeen for those affected by Dementia and their carers. (One venue has not yet started operating again after the pandemic but this now progressing).

Working links have been made with local organisations, Aberdeen Council of Voluntary Organisations (ACVO) Aberdeen City Council and NHS Grampian in order to deliver the services and ensure that needs are being met.

The befriending co-ordinator reinvigorated the befriending part of the service.

The main achievement was the successful operation and growing attendance of all three cafes operated by the project.

Any reserve funds held are required to meet future obligations in terms of salaries and expenses in relation to the operation of both services.

Securing grant funding has been and remains challenging and the charity has had to increasingly rely on private donations and fundraising events whilst seeking out higher value and recurrent grant funding. The charity has been able to rely on funds held in reserve from previous years where there is any shortfall between income and expenditure. However it has been fortunate to secure funding from local companies and some smaller grants.
