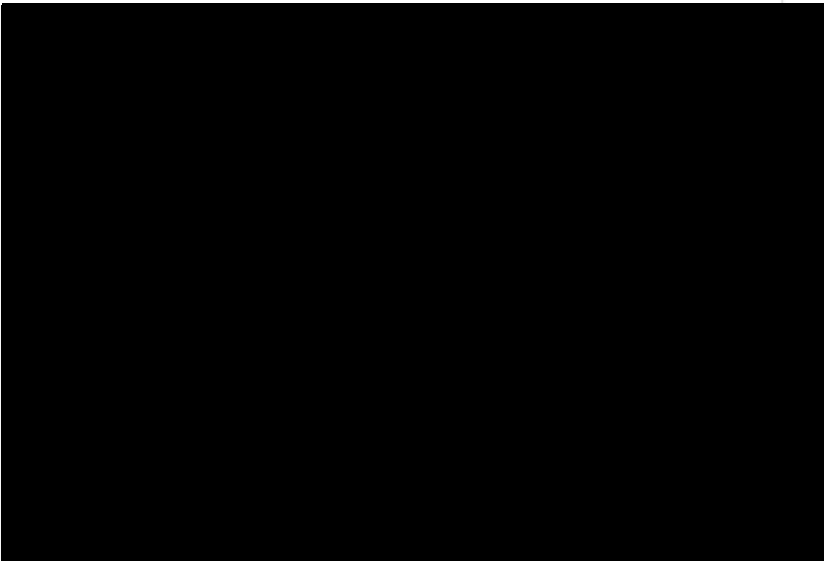
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**INVERURIE EVENTS

Recruitment and appointment of trustees

Trustees are appointed or reappointed at the AGM.

Governing document

The charity is unincorporated and the purposes and administration arrangements are set out in our constitution.

Charitable purposes

Inverurie Events organise and deliver many community events throughout the year for the people of Inverurie, and help to attract visitors from outwith the town. We involve many community groups in our events.

Activities and achievements

Our main event is the Christmas Lights Switch on which takes place around the last weekend in November each year and includes a St Andrews Day parade with many local community groups taking part. We also have a large number of local food vendors, children's entertainment and various local craft, food and drink stalls. The switch-on concludes with a fireworks display from above the town hall. We have organised the Pride of Inverurie awards for the past 5 years which culminates in a presentation dinner in Inverurie Town Hall. We also held a street party to celebrate the King's Coronation with food stalls, pipe bands and entertainment, an In Tune event, as well as a Ladies Day and a Christmas Party.

Future plans

We are looking to continue putting on our usual annual events and some other new ones, including a musical festival, hopefully in the very near future.

Financial review

As a result of the deficit of £2,998 for the year (2022 - surplus of £7,663), the committee held unrestricted funds totalling £9,967 (2022 - £12,965).

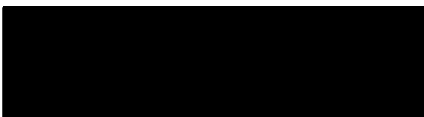
Committee remuneration and expenses

INDEPENDENT EXAMINER'S REPORT TO THE COMMITTEE OF INVERURIE EVENTS

I report on the accounts of the charity for the year ended 30 November 2023 which are set out on pages 6 and 7.

Respective responsibilities of committee and examiner

The charity's committee is responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the terms of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006. The charity committee considers that the audit requirements of Regulation 10(1) (d) of the Accounts Regulations does not apply. It is my responsibility to examine the accounts as required under section 44(1) (c) of the Act and to state whether particular matters have come to my attention.

Basis of independent examiner's statement

My examination is carried out in accordance with Regulation 11 of the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts, and seeks explanations from the committee concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit, and consequently I do not express an audit opinion on the view given by the accounts.

Independent examiner's statement


In the course of my examination, no matter has come to my attention
