Structure, Governance and Management

Legal status

The Trust is a Scottish Charitable Incorporated Organisation. It was registered as a charity on 29th January 2014.



Organisational structure

The trustees meet as and when required and are responsible for the strategic direction and policy of the charity. A considerable amount of trustees' business is transacted by written resolution or email correspondence among the trustees.

Objectives and Activities

Charitable purposes

The objects of the Trust are to:

- The prevention or relief of poverty;
- The relief of those in need by reason of age, ill health, disability, financial hardship or other disadvantage;
- The advancement of health; and
- The advancement of animal welfare.

Activities



The charity has income below £250,000 and as such is eligible to prepare its accounts on a Receipts and Payments Basis. The governing document does not require the charity to prepare fully accrued accounts and neither does it require an audit.

The Trust's funds are held in the most advantageous bank account and investment within the risk appetite determined by the trustees having taken appropriate financial advice.

Reserves Policy

The Trustees do not consider it necessary to have a reserves policy.

All new projects undertaken or supported will be evaluated by the trustees and will remain in line with the objectives of the Trust. The Trust intends to fully utilise all existing reserves and does not plan actively to raise additional funding but will accept donations.
