User group activity in our main facility, the Glenkens Community Centre, continued to grow, building on the progress of the previous year. Work began in assessing the structure of the centre roof and the basement ceiling to carry out future, much needed upgrades to the building. A small grant was raised towards upgrading and planting out the front garden outside the Glenkens Community Centre, and a plan was drawn up with the community for use of the back garden, for which funds still need to be raised.

An asset transfer began for the acquisition of the Multi-Use Games Area (MUGA) in Dalry, which is still pending, and the Trust raised its first grant funding from D&G Council for the resurfacing of the area.
